The Colleges Sports Academy is also based within the section and we now offer sports academies in Athletics, Badminton, Basketball, Cricket, Football, Golf, Netball, Rugby, Swimming, Table Tennis and Tennis. Our biggest academy is the Football Academy (male and female) which we run in conjunction with The Chelsea Foundation.
